## Easy Access Services

Busways' easy access services improve accessibility for people with disabilities, elderly and less mobile passengers. All benefit from the buses equipped with ultra low floors and ramped entry which provide stepless access to the front section of the vehicle.

The buses also feature wider aisles at entry, designated wheelchair spaces, additional priority seating for the elderly and less mobile, increased interior lighting and an extendable wheelchair ramp.

Easy access services are identified in our timetables with a wheelchair symbol.

Our fleet will continue to be upgraded with ultra low floor easy access buses, in line with disability legislation.

Busways reserves the right to substitute a non-accessible bus on trips marked accessible if operational circumstances dictate.
